Wounded Warrior Project to Participate in Combined Federal Campaign **Fundraising Initiative Open to All Federal Employees Starting Oct. 2**

JACKSONVILLE, Fla., Oct. 2, 2017 /PRNewswire-USNewswire/ -- Wounded Warrior Project® (WWP) will once again participate in the Combined Federal Campaign (CFC), the world's largest annual workplace charitable giving campaign. CFC provides an opportunity for military and civilian federal employees to support causes they believe in.

The funds raised through CFC provide WWP the support needed to ensure its programs and services continue to be provided free of charge to warriors, their families, and caregivers.
