The Milwaukee Air & Water Show is a family event on the shores of Lake Michigan. Warriors and families who attended were thrilled with the water ski and speedboat demonstrations, and the U.S. Air Force Thunderbirds performance. A big reason to be there, however, was the <u>opportunity to network with other warriors</u>

"I enjoyed the camaraderie and being able to meet other warriors and family members from different places," Yamilet said.
